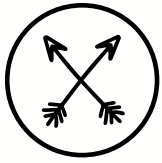

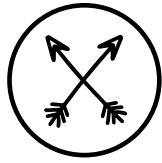

What Do We Do?

Every Sunday morning at 9:00 am and each Wednesday night at 7:00 pm, the Bartlett Woods Youth Group meets in Room 102 for singing, prayer, and a Bible lesson. Sunday morning classes are focused more on diving into the text of God's word in a particular passage. Wednesday night classes are focused more on what God's word says about a particular topic. After a joint Bible lesson on Wednesday nights, students break out into small groups called "Oasis Groups." Each Oasis Group is led by two members of the Bartlett Woods church of Christ. In order to gain the most from the lesson in application, each group is grade and gender specific. All classes taught in the youth program are biblically based and sound.



Who is the Youth Group For?



The Bartlett Woods Youth Group is for students who have just finished their fifth grade year through those students who have just completed their senior year. The youth ministry does activities involving all students (6th - 12th), as well as activities specifically for Junior High (6th - 8th), and activities specifically for Senior High (9th - 12th).
